Natural sanctuary and healing center for the wildlife, the Marais aux Oiseaux welcomes numerous bird species that coexist in this safe heaven.

« Welcome to our home! Please stay on the main path, so the animals and the visitors make the best of this magical place. You'll find out that we're never too far! »



Each year, a rough amount of 2000 wild species are taken care of in the departmental healing center. It's closed to visitors to allow their recovering.



The « Espaces Naturels sensibles » (Vulnerable natural places, ENS) are sectors that are preserved, handled and valued by the department of Charente-Maritime.

Thanks to the Echappées Nature network, you can come and visit those places all year, which enables you to discover a unique and rich natural heritage.


